

General Information

COSTS : The land cost for 2007 Summer Tours were **\$3495 per person dbl. occupancy. Single Supplement at \$50 extra per night = \$450** for the 10 nights. * 8 nights at Holiday Inn Norwich 2 nights at airport hotel on arrival night & before departure).08 cost not available yet

We would appreciate it if all couples that wish to share a double bed, designate that preference on the questionnaire. Air transportation is not included in the land tour cost and will vary according to the city of departure. The tour consists of 8 days of detecting and 3 days of transport. (air and coach) with 8 nights spent at Norwich Holiday Inn & 2 nights at Heathrow or Gatwick Hotel

NOT INCLUDED: Air Fare is not included, nor are items of personal nature, such as alcoholic beverages.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS INCLUDE :

10 nights First Class hotel accommodations with private baths. Full English breakfasts, box lunches while detecting on fields & gourmet dinners while in Norwich. The Airport Hotels include Continental Breakfast. All ground transportation by private motorcoach and driver from the time of arrival in England to the return to the Airport..Usage Fees to farmer's fields. Services of archaeologists and staff for identification & recording of finds & Export Procurement . **Note*** If for any reason a participant fails to meet DTI coach at airport hotel on arrival in UK, DTI will suggest alternative transportation but will not be liable for any expenses to transport passenger to Norfolk hotel. CANCELLATION OF TRIP : If DTI has to cancel the tour prior to departure, for any reason, all monies paid will be fully refunded. DTI assumes no further responsibilities beyond this refund. DTI reserves the right to remove a person from the tour if he/she is disruptive to the tour and/or presents a danger to others

RESPONSIBILITY:

Discovery Tours International through Operation Europe acts only as agents for the passenger with respect to transportation and hotels and exercises every care possible. However, we can assume no liability for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity in connection with the services of any airplane, automobile, motor coach or any other conveyance used in carrying out this tour or for the acts or defaults of any company or person engaged in conveying the passenger or in carrying out the arrangements of the tour. We cannot accept any responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delay in air or other services, sickness, bad weather, strike, war, quarantine, acts of God or other causes beyond our control and reserve the right to make such alterations to the itinerary as may be deemed necessary for carrying out the tour. By forwarding the deposit, the passenger certifies that he/she does not have any mental, physical or any other condition or disability that would create a hazard for him/herself or other passengers. Baggage is the owner's risk entirely. Tour participants understand the hazards of traveling by foot over rural terrain and plowed fields and accept the responsibility and risks of this activity. In consideration of and as part payment for the right to participate in such tour, the participant agrees to assume all of the above risks and agrees that such payment shall also constitute consent to all provisions contained herein. In addition, it is understood that Discovery Tours makes no guarantee, explicit or implied, as to the number or value of artifacts, coins or jewelry which the participant might recover, but will endeavor to provide the very best locations and sites available to them to insure the continued success of their tours. Detector Finds are shipped by Royal Mail from the UK to USA. Royal Mail will no longer insure antiquities and thus DTI cannot assume responsibility for this portion of the shipping. DTI will ship finds to each participant by US Registered Mail, Insured from their office when received from the UK.

THUNDERSTORMS : During Summer months lightning storms are common. We advise you to leave the fields immediately if this should occur and seek cover in a farm building. Continuing to remain on field will be at your own risk.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS :

An initial questionnaire will be sent to all persons requesting information on the tour. Those indicating on the questionnaire that they "**wish to be included**" on the tour are required to submit a check for \$500 deposit per person with their questionnaire. These funds will be held in a Trust Account at Wells Fargo Bank. and will hold the place on the specified tour. The balance of the tour cost will be due and payable on request from DTI and is usually about June 1st.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS :

Land tour deposits are fully refundable up until 120 days prior to departure. If notification of cancellation is received between 120 and 60 days prior to departure a \$100 penalty per person may be charged. If a cancellation is received between 60 and 30 days prior to departure, 25% of the total tour price may be charged as penalty and if cancellation is received less than 30 days prior to departure, 100% of total tour price will be charged.

TREASURE ACT 1996 : *(Details supplied in UK)*

All items found remain the property of the finder except where the Treasure Act applies. Anything that is reported to the Coroner that falls within the category of Treasure, the landowner has the right to 50% ownership. In the event the Treasure is purchased by a museum or 3rd party, the reward will be divided 50% landowner & 50% finder unless the value is \$10,000 or above. In that case, the finder's 50% will be divided 1/3 to the Finder or Finders, 1/3 to Discovery Tours and Staff and 1/3 equally among the other members of that group. In addition, if an item of important historical significance is found, the finder may be requested to sell, donate or loan that item to the local museum. Discovery Tours accepts the responsibility for identifying all finds to the best of their ability and for providing archaeological assistance in furthering that identification, as well as recording all finds for the Portable Antiquities Scheme. Discovery Tours will apply for export licences as required and ship items to the finder, except in very rare instances where the Government refuses a licence for an item deemed crucial to the English Heritage.
